This Declaration of Conformity confirms that our company generally complies with the applicable legal requirements, including the current version of the PPWR, and acts accordingly; it relates exclusively to the packaging described in Section 4.

4. Subject of the statement

The packaging consists of printed and unprinted product packaging and shipping boxes; depending on their weight and destination, these are sealed using either packing tape and/or strapping. Depending on the application, bubble wrap, air cushions and packing paper are used as filling material. UPS labels and dispatch envelopes are used to identify recipients and forward delivery notes.

5. Union legislation

The manufacturer declares that the packaging described in Section 4 has been assessed, on the basis of the available technical documentation, information from upstream suppliers and the conformity assessment carried out, in relation to the applicable requirements of the current Regulation (EU) 2025/40 – in particular heavy metals as set out in Article 5(4) and PFAS as set out in Article 5(5) – and that it complies with these requirements.

6. Harmonised standards / Common specifications

The following documents were used for the assessment, where applicable:

- specifications
- scientifically recognised test methods
- internal validation reports

7. Conformity assessment procedure applied

Conformity was assessed in accordance with the conformity assessment procedure set out in Annex VII to Regulation (EU) 2025/40.

- carried out an assessment of compliance with the applicable requirements
- documented the necessary evidence
- appropriate procedures have been put in place to ensure the ongoing conformity of series production.

The manufacturer shall ensure that all packaging placed on the market continues to comply with the requirements of the PPWR and that any changes to its design, materials or manufacture are subject to a new conformity assessment.
