Helmholz GmbH & Co. KG Supplier declaration in accordance with RoHS Directive 2011/65 / EU with additions 2015/863 & 2017/2102 and Article 33 of the REACH Regulation 1907/2006

Unless otherwise stated, Helmholz GmbH & Co.KG assures that the mass percentage of restricted substances according to directive 2011/65/EU and its supplements, delegated directive 2015/863 as well as directive (EU) 2017/2102, are complied with for the items sold.

The valid substance restrictions under directive 2011/65 / EU and its supplement 2015/863 are:

- Lead, maximum 0.1%
- Mercury, maximum 0,1%
- Cadmium, maximum 0.01%
- hexavalent chromium, max. 0.1%
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB), maximum 0,1%
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE), maximum 0,1%
- Bis(2-ethylhexyl)phthalat (DEHP), maximal 0,1%
- Benzylbutylphthalat (BBP), maximal 0,1%
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP), maximum 0.1%
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP), maximum 0.1%

Information according to Article 33 according to REACH:

Unless otherwise stated, Helmholz GmbH & Co.KG assures that most of the delivered articles do not contain any "Substances of Very High Concern" (SVHC) according to the current candidate list. According to the rules of the European Court of Justice, this is also to be applied to partial products.

7a	Lead in refractory solders, i.e. lead-based solder alloys with a lead content of at least 85% by mass
7c I	Electrical and electronic components containing lead in glass or ceramic materials other than dielectric ceramics in capacitors, e.g. piezo electronic devices
7c II	Lead in dielectric ceramic in capacitors for a rated voltage of 125 V AC or 250 V DC or above
8b	Cadmium and cadmium compounds in electrical contacts
